Highlighted Topic: Summer programming has begun. Kids Garden Club started June 12^{th,} 11:00 am every other Wednesday for ages 8+; Teen & Tween Cafe started June 6th 3:30 pm every other Thursday. The Summer Reading Program started and this morning 28 kids attended a fishing presentation by the Department of Wildlife.
